

Flag Book Album

Create an awesome gift album using small onboard book basics and designer paper.

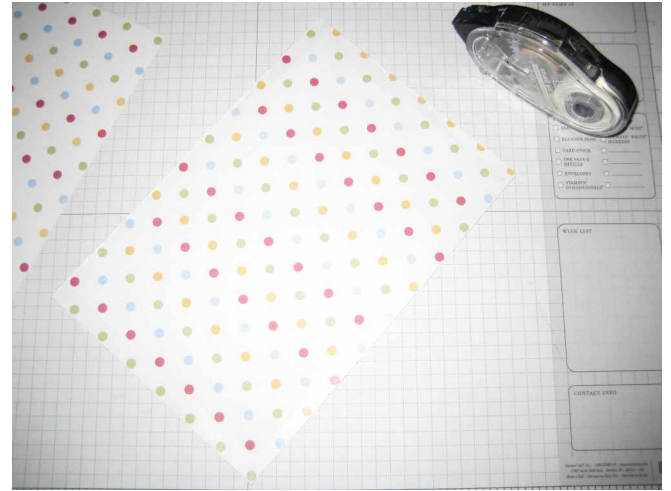
Supplies



- 1 pair Small Book Basics
- 6 sheets 8.5x11 cardstock of two coordinating colors (cut to 6x11)
- 9 Tags cut 2.5x4 (6 of one color, 3 of another)
- 3 white cardstock cut 2.25x3.75 (to use over tags)
- 4 pieces of 5x7.5 designer paper (two designs)
- 9 round tab punches
- 1 piece of 4x7.5 solid cardstock
- Paper trimmer with scoring blade (or Scor-Pal)
- Scissors
- Sticky Strip™
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Stamps, Ink, Ribbon, Snail Adhesive

Step-by-Step

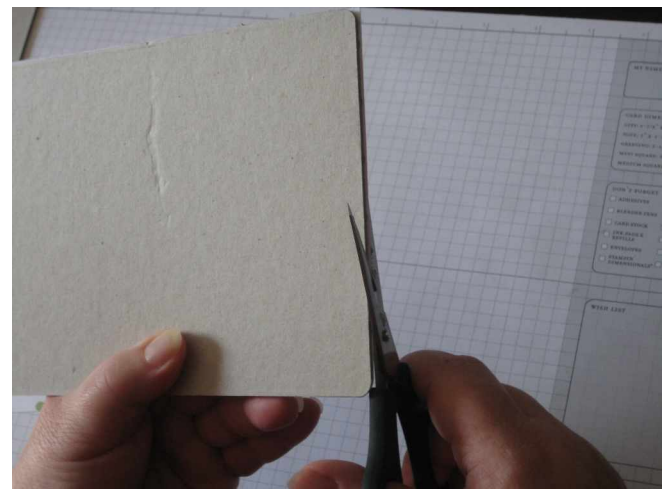
1. Step 1
Apply snail adhesive along every edge of wrong side of designer paper being sure to go all the way to the edge.



2. Step 2
Adhere to front of one book basic.



3. Step 3
Trim excess paper.



4. Step 4

Use sanding block or other sanding implement to smooth edges. Repeat steps 1-4 with second book basic piece.



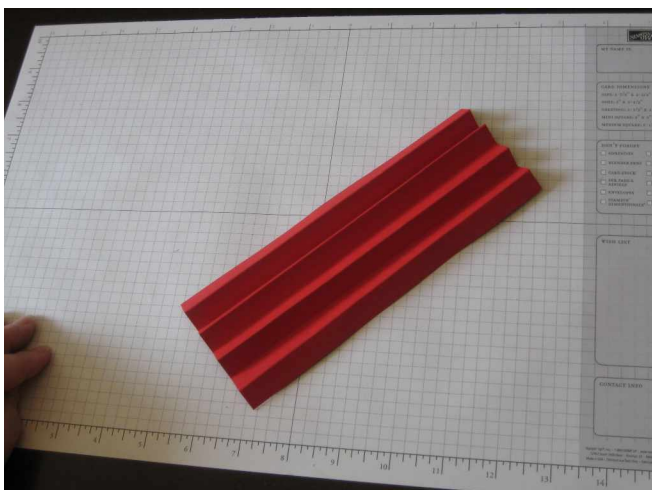
5. Step 5

Score 4x7.5 piece of cardstock at 1/2 inch intervals.



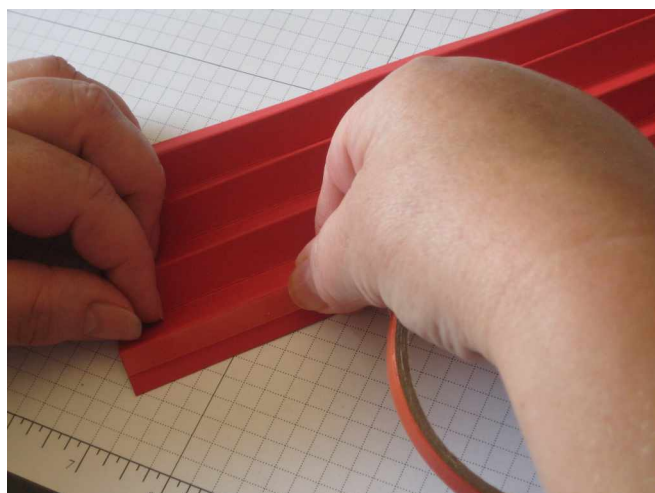
6. Step 6

Fold accordion style.



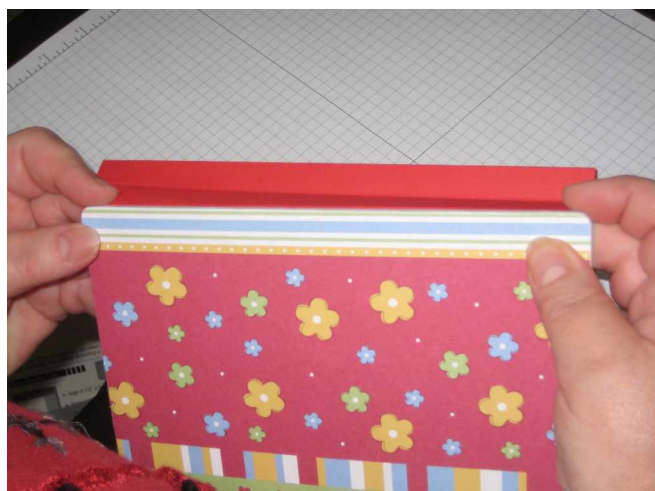
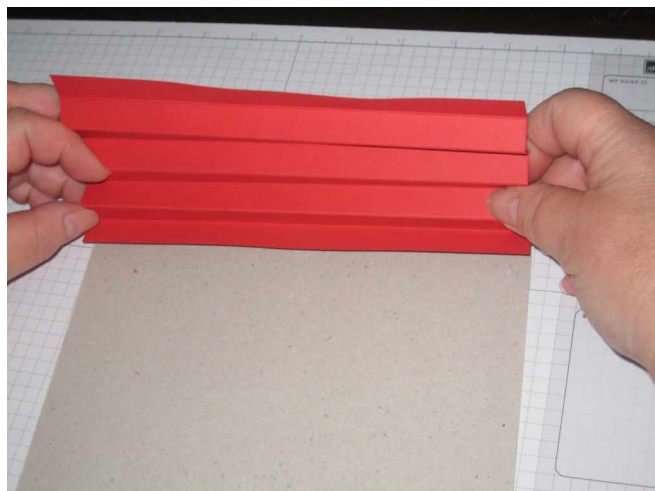
7. Step 7

Apply sticky strip to each side near peak (so it will be at the edge when stuck to book).



8. Step 8

Adhere each end to inside of book.



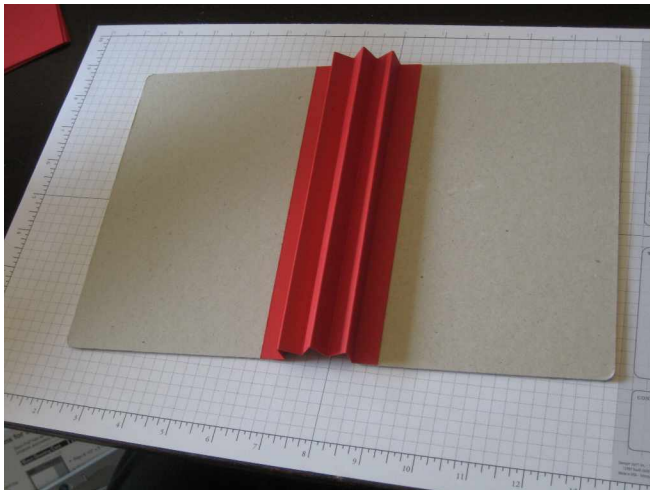
11. Step 11
Insert tags to side of accordeon as shown.



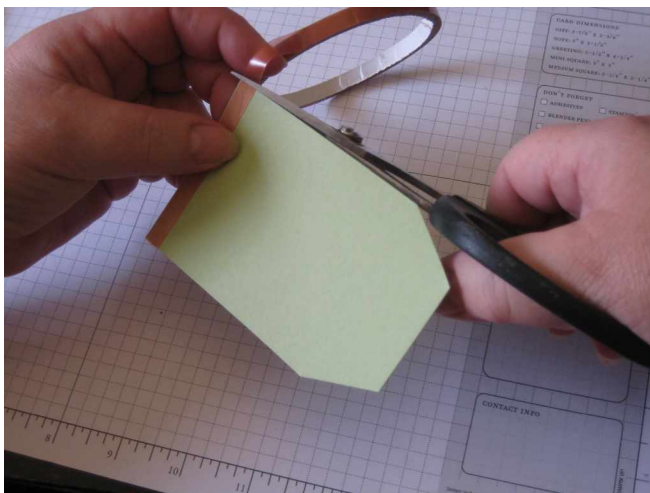
9. Step 9
Cover with alternate patterned designer paper (Inside of both covers).



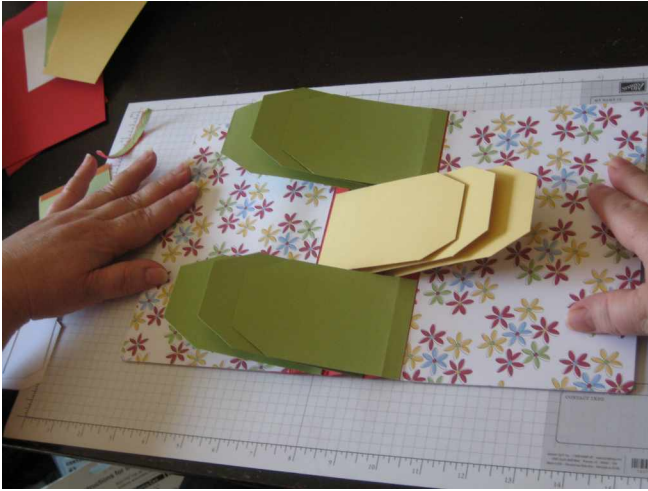
Continue until all 9 tags have been inserted.



10. Step 10
Apply sticky strip to end of each tag.



12. Step 12
Tags should fold alternately when book is opened.



13. Step 13
Stamp design on white cardstock and adhere to top tags only. Add round tab punches to each tag.



14. Step 14
Embellish front as desired. Can add ribbon to tie closed if desired.



Step-by-Step Ribbon Flower

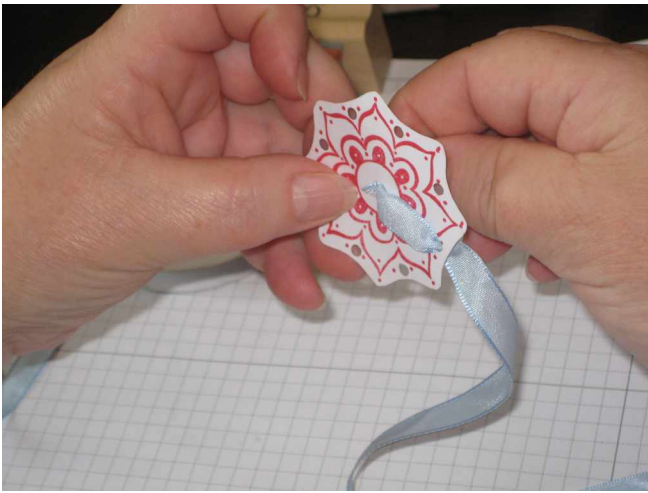
15. Step 15
Stamp flower. (I used One of a Kind, but True Friend works well also. Punch each circle around outside of flower using a 1/8" hand punch.



16. Step 16
Punch large hole in center of flower using crop-o-dile.



17. Step 17
Cut 20" piece of taffeta ribbon. Place ribbon from top down hole in center, then adhere end to back side of flower.



18. Step 18
Pull ribbon down through edge hole then back up through center. Repeat all around.



19. Step 19
Trim excess ribbon and adhere to back side. Mount with dimensionals to base cardstock and trim flower. (See album front)
